### **Nominations**

With the 2018 annual conference coming just around the corner, I hope you will consider **nominating one of your colleagues** for one of the following awards. Send your nominations to me directly at <u>abrowning@hollins.edu</u>. Nominate a peer for:

**HONORARY MEMBERSHIP** Reserved for individuals who have been long-term and valued members of VACRAO and who are no longer eligible for voting or associate membership in the association. They should have a significant record of contributions to the admissions and records profession or must have taken a leadership role in VACRAO

**NEW PROFESSIONAL AWARD** Reserved for individuals with one to five years of experience in the profession. Nominees must exhibit professionalism and expertise in their field at their institution. Their interest in and significant contributions to VACRAO are key considerations, along with their potential for leadership in VACRAO and other related professional associations.

**DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD** The highly selective, "lifetime achievement" award is reserved for individuals whose service to VACRAO has been so extraordinary as to warrant special consideration while still active or for individuals retiring.

### **Professional Development**

The VACRAO Annual Professional Development Scholarship offers financial support to VACRAO members for two professional scholarships given annually. One individual member will be selected to attend SACRAO, and one individual member will be selected to attend AACRAO, allowing VACRAO members greater exposure to regional and national conferences, as well as, significant opportunity for professional development. Conference dates and locations for 2019 are:

### SACRAO – February 3 – 6, 2019; Baton Rouge, Louisiana AACRAO – March 31 – April 3, 2019; Los Angeles, California

Upon returning from the selected conference, VACRAO will require the scholarship award winners to bring forth a session idea/presentation for VACRAO's annual conference, allowing our membership to be more aware of pertinent issues that exist both regionally, as well as nationally. To be eligible, applicants must be employed by an institution who holds a current VACRAO membership, be a current full-time employee with their fellow institution in either the Admissions or Registrar's Office and have been employed in their respective office for at least 1 year.

Awards will not exceed \$1500.00; and must be used only for registration fees, travel and/ or lodging reimbursements. **Contact me at <u>abrowning@hollins.edu</u>** to access the scholarship application.

This has eliminated all of the back-and-forth that previously took place, and encouraged those schools eager to receive the registration link to pay their membership dues!

#### **CVENT**

I have created the proposal site and will next begin the conference registration site.

As of August 31, we have used 67% (532/800) of our registrations through C-Vent. If we need to purchase additional registrations, the rate is \$2.00 per registration if purchased before we exhaust ours; it is \$3.00 each if we go over our allotted registrations.

Note: Our current C-vent cycle is May 1- April 30 and runs through April 30, 2019.
